





 Monday	Can children be given jobs or tasks to support you around the house. We'd love to see children becoming more confident in helping!	Practice making comparisons using cubes for the numbers we know. Which is the biggest number? Smallest number? Experiment and investigate.	Read Jack and the Beanstalk. Ask questions throughout e.g. What do you think might happen in this book? Who are the characters? Different about them?	Can you clap the syllables in your name with an adult? Rhyming Soup Can an adult help you gather a collection of objects that rhyme? E.g. rat, hat, cat and have a bowl and a spoon to act out the song including list of objects: (Pop Goes the Weasel tune) - I'm making lots of silly soup, I'm making soup that's silly, I'm going to cook it in the fridge, To make it nice and chilly, In goes,, a fox.. A box.. Have fun - we can't wait to find out what books you're reading!! Have a look at our Winnie the Pooh forest activity if you're going on a daily walk.
 Tuesday	Practice your throwing and catching skills. We'd love to see if you can get further away each time!	Look at the picture of a beanstalk. Can you describe what it looks like. Can you clap the syllables in your name with an adult? Put a variety of objects in a bag or box (some that rhyme). Can children pick objects out of box 1 at a time and call out when an object rhymes with another? Choose a song or nursery rhyme to sing. https://wordsforlife.org.uk/themes/songs-and-rhymes/	Have you got any instruments in your house? Experiment making sounds. With an adult, can you make different sounds around your house? Can you make a quiet, loud, quick and slow sound?
 Wednesday	Continue to practice copying letters. Can you practice 1 new letter of your name today?	Using templates of a variety of shapes e.g. ovals for leaves, rectangles for stems - can children recreate a beanstalk. Ask an adult for help, cutting out templates. We'd love to see beanstalks you can make!	Create a story map/recap the stories learnt this week. Who are the characters? What happens? Has Jack learned any lessons? Etc.	Just like plants, how do we look after ourselves? Is there anything we both need? We'd love to know what you think!	Can you clap the syllables in your name with an adult? Collect a variety of objects that have different syllable patterns e.g. pencil umbrella, camera, xylophone (or whatever you have around the house) What do you know about these objects? Clap the syllables for each object. Can an adult clap the number of syllables and children guess which object it is?  Thursday	Continue to practice copying letters. Can you practice 1 new letter of your name today?	Have you got any belts in your house. Find some and place them one on top of the other. Which is the biggest? Smallest? Use cubes or lego pieces to begin to use units to support measurement.	Read an alternative version... https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ZyjkQcCbIT0 'Trust Me, Jack's Beanstalk stinks'	Can you print something or copy something if you have a printer at home? What did you need to do to make it work? If not, choose another piece of technology.	Can you clap the syllables in your name with an adult? Hickory Dickory Dock. Children could join in with voice sounds e.g. weeee as mouse falls down. Use this to find words that rhyme e.g. dock, clock, tick, tock. Substitute alternative rhyming sounds to make it fun. Choose a song or nursery rhyme to sing. https://wordsforlife.org.uk/themes/songs-and-rhymes/	Maths - out and about. Can you practice your counting or see shapes around the house or outside and show us e.g. counting plates or steps on stairs.
 Friday	Continue to practice copying letters. Can you practice 1 new letter of your name today?	Using seeds can children correctly match with numicon or numeral amount e.g. can you get 3 seeds. Can children pick 3 correctly! We'd love to see your amazing counting skills!	Which was your favourite version? Why? Who are the characters? Comparisons.	Can you practice with an adult changing the pitch of your voice? We'd love to see you practicing!	Can you clap the syllables in your name with an adult? Continue as above but for different rhymes and songs. Choose a song or nursery rhyme to sing. https://wordsforlife.org.uk/themes/songs-and-rhymes/	Can you keep a diary of what you have done this week for your daily exercise? What have you been up to?
