September Organisation:

In September we will still be using the bubble model to ensure our school community is as protected as possible. We are going to adopt the 'year group' bubble approach, which will allow for the smooth running of the day, and for children to be able to access any additional support they may need across the year. Different year group bubbles however, will not cross over. Therefore we will have to stagger start times and end times of the day, as well as playtimes and lunchtimes. In order to ensure the smooth transition and return of pupils to school we will also be staggering start dates.

Important - Social Distancing Rules:

- Children must be escorted onto the school premises by 1 adult only.
- Please ensure that you are on time for your bubble opening / closing time and that you walk with your child staying 2 metres away from others, lining up outside classroom doors using the 2 metre markings.
- There will be a one way system for parents to enter school (the main gate by the school office) and exiting school (the far gate by the school field)

Uniform:

- Children will need to be in school uniform and can bring packed lunches, water bottles, bags, coats and iPads into school.
- If your child has a pencil case we would like them to bring this into school this way we can minimise the sharing of resources.
- Please make sure that your child is in a clean uniform.

PE / Forest school:

We are happy to say that this will be resuming next academic year. On the days that your child has PE or Forest School, they must come into school in the outdoor PE uniform - please see the website for details. While additional protective measures are in place children will not be able to wear school waterproofs or spare kit - we ask that children have their own pair of wellies and a waterproof coat on their Forest School day.

Lunchtimes:

Our school kitchen has been closed since March and the children in school are currently having packed lunches for dinner. In September, there will be a hot meal available, see website for details. All children entitled to free school meals will receive the hot option, packed lunches will no longer be available. If your child requires a packed lunch this will need to provided from home.

General Protective Measures:

There are a whole host of protective measures that we will be putting in place in order to keep your child safe - please see the policy that is on our website. Children will be regularly hand washing in school. We will have an enhanced cleaning programme that will run throughout the school day and deep cleans will occur during holiday periods, plus additional cleans if any child is poorly.

Test, Track and Trace:

It is important, in order to keep our whole school community safe, that you adhere to the rules around test, track and trace. If your child has any symptoms (persistent cough, high temperature, loss of taste or smell) you MUST keep your family at home and contact school immediately. If your child becomes ill at school, a member of staff wearing PPE will help support your child to an isolated area, and you will be contacted straight away. In both cases, we will let you know what you need to do, but a test is **vital**, as the result will depend on whether your child can come back to school.



















Breakfast Club / After School clubs:

In September, initially in the Autumn Term, Breakfast Club will run for working parents only. Places will be limited and a booking system will be in place. This will start on Monday 7th September. We will send out more details in September. There will be no after school clubs during the first half term, this will be reviewed after the October holidays.

I apologise that there is a lot of information here, but I wanted you to know as much as possible. We are working extremely hard to protect our children and ensure they receive a full education at the same time.
